

Queer* Department Call for Nominations from ANUSA President/Returning Officer.

I hereby call for nominations for the vacant position of Queer* Officer 2021. The Queer* Officer is responsible for the management of the affairs of the Queer* Department. Their role is defined in the Queer* Department Constitution as:

8.2.1 Queer* Officer

8.2.1.1 The Queer* Officer is an advocate for all members of the Department.

8.2.1.2. Recognising that the Collective is the primary decision-making and organising body of the Department, and that the Officer is required to act in accordance with the directives of the Collective, the Officer must:

- 8.2.1.2.1 Make all reasonable efforts to carry out the objects of the Department through collective discussion and decision-making.
- 8.2.1.2.2 Make all reasonable efforts to inform the Collective of all substantive motions at upcoming meetings of the ANUSA Student Representative Council (SRC).
- 8.2.1.2.3 Vote at any meeting of the ANUSA SRC in accordance with the direction of the Collective, in recognising that the Officer is the representative of the Department in all their dealings with ANUSA.
- 8.2.1.2.4 Account, at the next meeting of the Collective, any decisions made without prior Collective discussion and approval.
- 8.2.1.2.5 Fulfill any duties in any way as determined by the Collective.

Any ordinary member of the Queer* Department may nominate for the role. All nominations are to be sent to sa.president@anu.edu.au by 5:05pm on the 22nd of September 2020. Nominations must include the nominee's name and student number. The Department will vote to select the 2021 Queer* Officer in the Week 7 Collective Meeting at 5:00pm on the 22nd of September 2020.
