Items

1. Woroni Amplify Article

This issue raised a very important issue. The potential for candidates to be supported in a way that may give unfair advantage to some over others through Woroni or other non-campaigners in terms of the regulations.

Of note that the ANUSM constitution refers to the Australian Press Council principles, but that would not be sufficient to ensure equitable treatment of candidates in terms of giving visibility to the ANU student population.

It may be worth exploring in future elections a process where there is a conversation with the Editor in Chief of Woroni the issue of election coverage of candidates when the call for nominations occurs.

Agree with the suggestions for "implementing changes" and "clarifying punishments".

2. Music in Union Court

Agree with the suggestions for "implementing changes".

3. Shark Cage Stalkerspace Content

This was quite a complex issue. Where a group that registers for the election has a preexisting identity managing the communication activities will inevitably be problematic. In this case the behaviour of members online were not consistent with the standard expected of any student, let alone those participating in an election.

It was a very regrettable set of incidents.

I strongly support the Probity Team's statements and conclusion that there are no changes recommended.
