*** Council Members Eligibility**

Only undergraduate students, as defined in the ANU Governance Rule and Statute may nominate for the position of Undergraduate Student University Council Member.
 Only postgraduate students, as defined in the ANU Governance Rule and Statute may nominate for the position of Postgraduate Student University Council Member.

**** Academic Officer Eligibility**

For the position of Undergraduate Coursework Officer, nominees must be students enrolled in an undergraduate program as defined by the University.
 For the position of Postgraduate Coursework Officer, nominees must be students enrolled in an postgraduate coursework program as defined by the University.
 For the position of Higher Degree by Research (HDR) Officer, nominees must be students enrolled in a higher degree by research program as defined by the University.

- Environment Officer**
 Any student may nominate. Nominees must also be an active member of the Department, meaning that they have attended at least three meetings of the Environment Department during the academic year or who are approved as an active member by a vote of the Environment Collective (ANUSA Election Regulations, R 7.3.2(b)).
- Parents and Carers Officer**
 Nominees for Parents and Carers' Officer must self-identify as a parent and/or a carer.
- College Representative**
 Only students enrolled in the relevant College are eligible to nominate. For each college, two positions are designated as undergraduate positions, one position is designated as a postgraduate coursework position and one position is designated as a Higher Degree by Research (HDR) position. Students must be enrolled in a program in the relevant academic career to be eligible to nominate.

Only ordinary members of the Association are eligible to vote or be nominated for these positions.

Only ANU students may nominate for ANU Council positions

A nominator must not nominate more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled.

Nominations must be lodged between 9am, Wednesday 21 August 2024 and 5pm, Friday 13 September 2024.

Ticket registrations must be lodged between 9am, Wednesday 21 August 2024 and 5pm, Wednesday 11 September 2024.

Ticket registrations, signed by 5 or more ordinary members of the Association, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the registration period. Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket.

Candidates may indicate the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates that they are running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives notice of the endorsement from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name.

If a registered ticket endorses more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled, all nominations from that ticket for that position shall be rejected.

Online polling will be held during Week 8, opening at 9am Monday 30 September and closing at 12pm Thursday 3 October 2024.

Legal obligations of nominees

Nominees should also consider whether they are disqualified from running for office by S63, 63A and 63B, of the Associations Act 1991 (ACT). The following people may be disqualified from holding office on ANUSA by legislation (unless they have obtained leave from the Supreme Court of the ACT):

- Those convicted of an indictable offence in relation to the promotion, formation or management of a company within the past 5 years.
- Those convicted of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty punishable by imprisonment for a period of 3 months or more within the past 5 years.
- Those who are bankrupt or personally insolvent.

Please note that the maximum penalty for non-compliance with these provisions is 50 penalty units (\$8000), imprisonment for 6 months, or both. If you have concerns about your eligibility under these provisions, please reach out to sa.principallawyer@anu.edu.au for a confidential appointment.
