There'll be a welcome, a fun question. The budget breakdown will have two components, that's Kat. Kai is doing a 'what is ANUSA' and housing stuff. People will be in their groups after i.e. gen reps and college reps to get a sense as a group. Exec will be dispersed. Be with the group you have the least to do with throughout the year to make sure we're getting to know different people. There will be breaks, I haven't timed the short ones, they'll be based on vibes. Phi will run something governance based. Ben and I will be running a session about ANUSA campaigns. It'll be open discussion and butcher's paper. The formal/info stuff first because this year there's less knowledge and relationship among reps so that people can feel comfy with some base level knowledge before they contribute to the later stuff. My session is on what are the goals for ANUSA, less campaigns more values driven than action driven. We'll finish around 5pm. Pack down and spreading word about dinner, hanging out in the BKSS. It does need to be properly packed down because there's a conference there the next day. In terms of COVID safety we need to wipe down everything.
