Election of Probity Officers

Probity Officers are to be elected at SRC 3 in accordance with clause 2.11.1 of the Election Regulations.

The role of Probity Officer is to assist the Returning Officer in managing the Annual Elections of the Association. Probity Officers have powers of inquiry and investigation under the Constitution to ensure that Annual Elections are conducted in accordance with the Regulations, and to report on breaches by candidates and tickets of Electoral Offences such as campaign expenditure limits.

Any undergraduate student of the ANU may nominate to fill the position. All nominees must sign a form declaring possible conflicts of interests before the close of nominations. Conflicts of interest may include:

- . a) Membership of a political party registered with the Australian Electoral Commission in any Australian State or Territory;
- . b) Membership of any Political Club or Society; or
- . c) Contesting, being elected to or otherwise holding, at any time, any office or position in ANUSA or the ANU Union Board.

Expressions of interest should be emailed to the General Secretary by **5pm on Friday, 13 April** at sa.gensec@anu.edu.au. Nominees will then be provided with a form to declare conflicts of interest as outlined above. Completed forms must be submitted by **5pm on Saturday, 14 April** for the nomination to be accepted.

Election of Disputes Committee Members

Up to five (5) members of the Disputes Committee are to be elected at SRC 3 in accordance with section 28(8) of the Constitution.

The Disputes Committee oversees disputes arising under the Constitution, the Regulations or any other Policy of the Association. Members of the Committee must undertake a thorough investigation into any matter referred to it, including disputes relating to the validity of resolutions calling for the dismissal of Representatives of the Association, and allegations of breaches of this Constitution and the Regulations.

The Committee may impose fines or revoke the membership rights of any member of the Association found to be in breach of the Constitution. As such, members of the Committee must be strongly impartial and appreciative of the seriousness of the role.

Any undergraduate student of the ANU who is not an elected Representative of the Association may nominate to fill the positions.
