Both ordinary and associate members are allowed to nominate. Only ordinary members of the Department are eligible to vote. All ANU undergraduate international students are automatically ordinary members of the International Students' Department.

Nominations must be lodged **between 9am, Monday 20 September and 5pm, Friday 24 September 2021**. Nominations must be sent by email to sa.admin@anu.edu.au.

Ticket registrations must be lodged **between 9am, Monday 20 September and 12pm, 5pm, Friday 24 September 2021**. Nominations must be sent by email to sa.admin@anu.edu.au.

Ticket registrations, signed by 3 or more ISD ordinary or associate members, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the registration period. Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket.

Candidates may indicate the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates that they are running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives the notice of the endorsement

from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name. If a registered ticket endorses more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled, all nominations from that ticket for that position shall be rejected.

Manifestos and Photos

Candidates have the option to include a manifesto and photo on the online election platform.

- Maximum of 150 words;
- Manifestos for individual candidates may be sent either in one document or in the email body;
- If a candidate is running for multiple positions, please specify which position the manifesto is for;
- Photos are max file size 900kb. Please ensure file names are the names of the candidate.

Online polling will open 9am Wednesday 29 September and closes 9am Monday 4 October.

Legal obligations of nominees

Nominees should also consider whether they are disqualified from running for office by s 63 of the Associations Act 1991 (ACT). The following people may be disqualified from holding office on ANUSA by legislation (unless they have obtained leave from the Supreme Court of the ACT):

Those convicted of an indictable offence in relation to the promotion, formation or management of a company within the past 5 years. Those convicted of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty punishable by imprisonment for a period of 3 months or more within the past 5 years. Those who are bankrupt or personally insolvent.

Please note that the maximum penalty for non-compliance with these provisions is 50 penalty units (\$8000) or imprisonment for 6 months. If you have concerns about your eligibility under these provisions, please reach out to sa.legal@anu.edu.au for a confidential appointment.
