Ethnocultural Officer						
Only those who self-identify as people of colour shall vote or nominate. This includes but is not limited to people who come from a minority ethnocultural background, are white-passing, are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, and have been marked or marginalised by white supremacy.

The candidate for a position of College Representative must be enrolled in the relevant College. Failure to enrol in relevant college will result in disqualification.

Only ordinary members of the Association are eligible to vote or be nominated for these positions.

A nominator must not nominate more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled.

Nominations must be lodged between 9am, Monday 15 July 2019 and 5pm, Wednesday 7 August 2019. Nominations must be placed in the locked ballot box provided in the ANUSA office, Level 2, Di Riddell Student Centre between 10am and 4pm on any week day during the period in which nominations are open.

Ticket registrations must be lodged between 9am, Monday 15 July 2019 and 5pm, Friday 2 August 2019. Ticket registration forms are available from the office of the Association or on the Internet at anusa.com.au and are to be lodged at the ANUSA office, Level 2, Di Riddell Student Centre.

Ticket registrations, signed by 5 or more ordinary members of the Association, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the registration period. Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket

Candidates may indicate the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates that they are running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives notice of the endorsement from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name.

If a registered ticket endorses more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled, all nominations from that ticket for that position shall be rejected.

The order of candidates on the voting paper will be determined on Monday 12 August 2019 commencing at 10am, ANUSA & PARSA Boardroom, Level 2, Di Riddell Student Centre. The order of candidates within a group endorsed by a registered ticket can be specified by that group if the request is received in writing by the Returning Officer before 5pm on Thursday 8 August 2019.
