7.1 Chair's report

- Josh Y has been going to many meetings
- Dealing mainly with O-week
 - Meeting with O-week coordinators about Market Day
- Functions on campus difficult to navigate due to COVID-19
 - o All events must be ticketed
 - o All events must have clear entry and exit point
- All clubs communicated with today by ANUSA about what Market Day entails
- Question: Are clubs going to be charged for Market Day?
 - CCE does not have authority
 - Charge has been waived for affiliated clubs this year
- Market Day: Clubs Night
 - Similar to cultural and language branch event
 - Hot food in Copland Courtyard
 - Maybe not hot food due to limited number of power points
 - o Will hopefully be a great night
- Badger event also being held
- Potential of clubs booklet being created
 - Turned into A5 leaflet
 - o ANUSA coordinators would put into O-week bag
- Contact with ANUSA president to have regular meetings
 - Proposed weekly or fortnightly meetings
 - Possibility they are too frequent

7.2 Secretary's report

- Written up interpretations to tackle the MSO proposed constitutional amendments re: quorum. This wouldn't have required non-executive members to be present to amend the constitution. It was only a proposed one, but wrote up an interpretation to clear it up.
- ANU Rock Music Society emailed re: issues around holding an AGM in Semester 2. As a new club, they came to the conclusion they were not required to hold an AGM and wouldn't be disaffiliated for not doing so. Can read the full interpretations elsewhere.
- Answering other emails.
- Met with Jeffrey re: the disaffiliation clause, wherein discovered an issue with club constitutions.
- Met with ANUSA re: a dispute. Talk more later.

7.3 Affiliations report

- Jeffery has continued to process re-affiliations
- Received 38 re-affiliation requests
- Couple of clubs which attempted to re-affiliate last year but didn't manage to re-affiliate
 - o This will be reviewed soon
- Market Day
 - Clubs wanting a stall will be considered affiliated so they can have a market day stall
- Constitution issues: to be discussed later
- Classics Society
 - They re-affiliate on a different cycle because they have AGM's in Sem 1 Week
 - o AGM for 2020 happened week 2 next year
- Question: why don't some club's affiliate?
 - They have specific membership requirements that don't meeting policy requirements
 - Want more flexible funding
 - o IAC, LSS are examples

7.4 Funding report

- Some requests have been declined
 - Some requests don't abide by COVID rules or funding policy
- One request for Pakistan Student Society has presented some issues
 - Can funding requests for last year be granted this year
 - o Dri is meeting with ANUSA to discuss further
 - o May come back to CCE
- Dri is meeting with Eleanor
 - o In regards to a funding discrepancy
- \$900 grant approved for Philosophy society
 - Issues with Academy
- Out of session motion for Academy Liquidity Grant



- Question: some affiliation requests may take a while but will ask for grants beforehand, is there any way for them to get funding for O-week before they are affiliated?
 - o Probably not
- Dri has also been writing financial training

7.5 Community report

- Training
 - Times for training being confirmed hopefully by end of week
 - o Many COVID issues to be dealt with
 - Marketing the next stage
 - o Plan
 - Hold 2 hour training session
 - Wednesday morning session 10 to 12 and evening session for 6 to 8

- A few constitutional issues with clubs
 - o Don't align to Aff policy
- Disaffiliation clause is a big issue
 - o 80% of constitutions don't have it
- Jeffery have been asking clubs to amend constitution to comply
 - However, this has presented more issues because some clubs have 'interesting' provisions to amend their constitution
- Solution: Jeffery will allow re-affiliation using his discretion on what is critical to
 have in a constitution and what is not. If it's not too critical then requirement will be
 waived
- Plan is to re-write affiliation policy in the year
