Only ordinary members of the Association are eliqible to vote or be nominated for these positions.

A nominator must not nominate more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled.

Nominations must be lodged between 10am, Monday 24 July 2017 and 4pm, Friday 11 August 2017. Nominations must be placed in the locked ballot box provided in the ANUSA office, Melville Hall, Building 12 between 10am and 4pm on any week day during the period in which nominations are open.

Ticket registrations must be lodged between 10am, Monday 24 July and 4pm, Wednesday 09 August, 2017. Ticket registration forms are available from the office of the Association or on the Internet at anusa.com.au and are to be lodged at the ANUSA office, Melville Hall, Building 12.

Ticket registrations, signed by 5 or more ordinary members of the Association, will be accepted by the Returning Officer during the registration period. Only those ticket names that have been duly registered will appear on ballot papers. No person is entitled to apply for registration of a ticket name if that person has already applied for the registration of another ticket.

Candidates may indicate the ticket with which they are running, or that they are running as an independent. Where a candidate indicates that she/he is running as a candidate endorsed by a registered ticket, the Returning Officer shall verify this endorsement if at least one of the nominators is a signatory to the application to register the ticket name or the Returning Officer receives notice of the endorsement from a signatory to the application to register the ticket name.

If a registered ticket endorses more candidates for election to a position than there are vacancies to be filled, all nominations from that ticket for that position shall be rejected.

The order of candidates within a group endorsed by a registered ticket can be specified by that group if the request is received in writing by the Returning Officer before 7 August.
