ANUSA has withdrawn its involvement with the ANU Gaza Solidarity Encampment due to comments made that were out of line with ANUSA policy. We continue to support the right of students to peacefully protest and want to ensure the safety of all students on our campus. All of our services remain open to all of our members and we encourage all students to feel confident accessing them.

We remain dedicated to calling for peace and the liberation of Palestine and continue to condemn the Israeli government for its actions in the Gaza Strip. ANUSA will continue its advocacy on Palestine.
